This historic residential structure was originally built around 1888...the last known substantial renovation occurred over time, between 1995-2000.

The scope of work for Repair and Replacement services per the certified engineered plans will include:

- Roof rafter and attic framing work,
- Shingled and flat roof replacement work,
- Addition of roof to wall hurricane tie downs,
- Front porch knee wall, post and screened openings demo and reconstruction,
- Addition of new Hurricane rated windows at front porch,
- Demolition and reconstruction of existing ADA accessible ramp and handrails,
- Modifying the detached ADA restroom by detaching exterior walls, top concrete floor, reset walls & roof, anchor to raised floor and repair disturbed siding. Replace all MEP fixtures, accessories, grab bars and add mini split AC unit,
- Repair interior drywall and/or exposed wood finish in historical residence, ADA restroom and front porch,
- Repair and replace as required, interior trim, doors and Hardware,
- Refinish stained interior floors. Repaint porch floors, apply epoxy non-slip floor finish to ADA restroom floor,
- Paint interior and exterior of residence and ADA restroom,
- Remove old and redesign and install new Irrigation system.
